Diocesan Dress Code for Confirmation

Young Men: Preferred – Dress shirt and tie, jacket or sweater, dress pants, dress shoes.

Other options – shirt with collar, long or short sleeves, dress slacks, dress shoes.

Young Ladies: Dress or skirt, long or short sleeve blouse or top that is modest, collared blouse or dress preferred. Length should be at least knee length or below. Long dress or skirt is fine. Low or medium heel dress shoes are appropriate (no flip-flops, please). No make up or dangling earrings. No hair spray near the face or forehead.
