\*One family has generously volunteered; we need at least one more! Help keep our newly renovated church shiny and sparkly!

Here is one family's experience:  
*"[We] clean on Sunday afternoons (flexible based on family's availability) and with the kids help, it now takes about an hour. We vacuum the rugs, sweep all of the floors including the entryways, spot mop as needed. We clean the bathroom and check supplies, we vacuum the cry room and clean the mirror, we sweep and vacuum the two sacristies and clean the surfaces and sinks, straighten the books in the pews and the side stations. It never really gets very dirty except the floors. Other things I do on a rotating, as needed basis such as dusting, scraping wax drips, etc. We then go back later in the week and do a "quick clean" which is usually vacuuming and checking/cleaning whatever needs to be done (less than an hour). Sometimes I just do this during my holy hour or after Mass in the morning. I like the quiet service."*
